MARCH 23rd – 28th – RECITAL PICTURE WEEK

Pictures will be taken on your regularly scheduled class day, at a scheduled time. This schedule will be emailed out before picture week begins. PLEASE NOTE: ALL Company students will take pictures on Saturday, March 28th. This includes Company ballet classes, solos, duet/trios, and all group dances. There will be no Company photos taken during the week.

NOTES

Please note! Since we are doing a Christmas Show this year, we will not be hosting an Open House at the studio during the month of December. However, we will be hosting a Customer Appreciation Month for the month of February with refreshments for our students and families in the kitchen, and this will give each class an opportunity to preview their children's recital music and costumes!

1. Rehearse with your child(ren) – Teachers will be glad to make you a copy of notes and music for your child to rehearse at home. Please email your teacher to receive the music.

PLEASE ENCOURAGE YOUR CHILD TO REHEARSE AT HOME. THIS WILL HELP WITH RETENTION SKILLS AND WILL ENSURE THAT HE/SHE WILL FEEL MORE CONFIDENT ABOUT HIS/HER DANCE.

- 2. Costumes and taking care of your costume(s) Costumes will be given out during the months of January-March. Please check to make sure you have all items with costumes such as hats, hairpieces, jewelry, etc. SCDC will help with major alterations, but we ask the parents to help with minor alterations. All outstanding account balances must be paid in full before children will be allowed to take their costume home. Please don't allow children to play in their costume at home. We recommend that your child's name be placed in all costumes, shoes, accessories, and tights. Place costumes in a garment bag with your child's name on the outside. Pack accessories in a clear plastic bag with your child's name on the bag and on each item. Costumes should be steamed before the performances. We prefer that costumes stay off of the floor.
- 3. Shoes and Tights Please make sure you have the correct shoe for your child's costume. Please see your teacher for the correct brand, style, and color of shoes needed for your students. Do not wait until the last day to purchase shoes as some items may be on backorder. If you wish to order dance shoes through the studio, please see the front desk ASAP.
- **4. Dance Undergarments Absolutely NO** panties are to be worn under costumes! Please explain to students that wearing a costume and tights is just like wearing a bathing suit. We encourage you to begin now if your child is uncomfortable not wearing panties with her dance clothes to class. For our older students, the SCDC staff will be glad to help dancers find the correct items for those who feel they need support garments under costumes.
- **5.** Hair and Makeup for stage and pictures- SCDC will post a make-up guide on the bulletin board in the lobby. We will be glad to make a copy for you. Pinks and Neutral colors are preferred...no blues, purples, greens etc. We recommend black eyeliner and black mascara. Younger students may wear minimal make-up. All female students must wear rhinestone earrings purchased from the studio (no extra jewelry). All fingernail and toenail polishes must be removed for the performances. Please see our recital supply guide for your class' hairstyle.
- **6. SCDC Survival Guide-** We recommend that you make a checklist of your child's routines, listing their costume, tights, shoes, and any accessories, and refer to it to make sure you have all your supplies before going to the theater. Bring at least one extra pair of tights of each color. Also bring extra hair gel, hairnets, bobby pins, and hairspray. Other handy extras include:
 - · Baby Wipes/ Shout Wipes (to fix makeup mistakes or wash hands)
 - · Baby Powder (for itchy costumes)
 - · Safety Pins (for emergency costume repairs)
- · Clear Nail Polish
- · Pain Reliever of Choice
- · Band-Aids (the "invisible" kind)

- 7. Dress Rehearsal at the Auditorium A dress rehearsal schedule will be given out to all students 3 weeks prior to the recital. Please make plans to attend this very important rehearsal...dates are May 22nd, 23rd, & 24th. Participation in the dress rehearsal is mandatory. Please arrive at least 30 minutes prior to your scheduled time. SCDC staff will help you find your dressing room. PLEASE MAKE SURE THE STUDENTS STAY IN THEIR DRESSING ROOM SO WE DO NOT HAVE TO SEARCH FOR THEM. MAKEUP IS NOT REQUIRED FOR DRESS REHEARSAL, HOWEVER, COSTUME AND HAIR IS REQUIRED. A responsible adult must accompany all students at all times. PLEASE DO NOT DROP OFF YOUR CHILD AND LEAVE THEM UNATTENDED. Please do not leave until your class has been dismissed. TEACHERS WILL BLOCK ALL DANCES ON STAGE WITHOUT THE MUSIC, HELP DANCERS WITH ENTRANCES AND EXITS TO AND FROM THE STAGE, AND THEN RUN THEIR DANCE WITH THE MUSIC. Parents may record or take photographs of their children at the dress rehearsal. Please Note: This will only be allowed at dress rehearsal as we have a professional videographer and photographer at all of the recitals.
- 8. SCDC Auditorium Accepted Behavior No eating, drinking, or smoking is allowed in the auditorium or dressing rooms during the dress rehearsal or recital. The same applies during the intermission and after the show. ALL ELECTRONIC DEVICES MUST BE TURNED OFF DURING THE PERFORMANCE. IF YOU MUST LEAVE THE AUDITORIUM DURING THE SHOW PLEASE LEAVE DURING A BLACKOUT. DO NOT STAND OR SIT IN THE AISLE. Absolutely no video or flash photography will be allowed in the auditorium at the recital. Dancers must remain backstage with their class mom until the end of the recital. NOBODY IS ALLOWED TO LEAVE FROM THE DRESSING ROOMS UNTIL OUR STAFF EXCUSES THEM. Please remind your families not to come backstage as there is limited space for props and dancers. Those who wish to greet performers after the show or present flowers should do so in the lobby areas. ABSOLUTELY NO PARENT OR GUARDIAN WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE SIDE OF THE STAGE. Only SCDC staff, volunteers, and performers will be allowed past the stage doors. Thank you for your cooperation.
- 9. **Recital Trophy Presentation** At South Carolina Dance Company we believe in rewarding every child for their continued dedication to the arts. At the conclusion of our 11:00, 2:00, 5:00, 7:30 and Sunday at 1:00 and 3:00 recitals, students will be presented with their awards. We present certificates to students with 2, 4, 6, 8, 9, 11, 12, 13, and 14 years of dance and a badge to first year dancers. For a \$10 fee, trophies are awarded to students who have studied dance for 3, 5, 7, 10, and 15 years. **ALL Parents, it is very important to verify your child's dance years using the form in this packet.** (We honor ALL dance years taken from other studios). NO students will be allowed in the auditorium until the conclusion of the awards presentation. PLEASE DO NOT COME GET YOUR CHILD DURING THE PERFORMANCE. FOLLOWING THEIR PERFORMANCE THEY ARE LINED UP FOR THE AWARDS CEREMONY. ALL VOLUNTEERS BACKSTAGE WILL HELP THE STAFF LINE UP THE CHILDREN FOR THE AWARDS CEREMONY.
- 10. Recital Volunteer Information We Need Volunteers: Anyone interested in volunteering to help backstage is welcome. A form will be given out to explain VOLUNTEER PROTOCOL. There will be a mandatory meeting for all volunteers PRIOR TO EACH REHEARSAL AT THE STUDIO DURING RECITAL PREP WEEK. All volunteers must work together in a cooperative manner at all times. All volunteers will receive an identification badge at the dress rehearsal, which must be worn in the theater at all times. Volunteers must remain backstage during the entire performance. However, you will be allowed to watch your child's performance from the front two rows in the auditorium....this will be a reserved section for volunteers. The door to the back stage area will be locked this year as you will not be able to enter as you please. We are trying to reduce noise and commotion back stage. Once again, students will not be allowed to leave the back stage area until the final awards presentation is completed.

Volunteers consist of:

Class mothers - They are responsible for making sure that each child is in the proper costume, has the proper accessories and shoes, and is backstage at the appropriate time. They are also responsible for seeing that all children return to their appointed dressing room after their time on stage. The number of volunteer moms needed for each class will be determined by the number of students (1 to 6 students = 1 volunteer; 6 to 12 students = 2 volunteers, etc). If there are too many volunteers for one class, some may be asked to work with children from another class.

We need male volunteers for the boy's dressing area as well as they are not near the female dressing rooms.

Prop DADS - We will need several dads for each show to help with heavy props. Sign-up today!

- **11. Recital Tickets & Program Book Policy -** Children 3 and under are admitted for FREE. VOLUNTEERS DO NOT NEED TO PURCHASE A TICKET. Tickets may be purchased for \$10. Only one ticket is needed for admission into all shows. Program books will be sold for \$10. Program book ad pages are due by March 1st.
- 12. Recital Photos Class photos will be taken during your child's regularly scheduled dance day. All students need to be present for their class picture. Students may get ready at the studio 1 hour before their scheduled class/picture time. ONLY THE SCDC STAFF WILL BE PERMITTED IN THE STUDIO WHERE PICTURES ARE BEING TAKEN. Please wear makeup and hair as specified for recital. After the group photo shoot, students may choose to have solo portraits made in any or all of their costumes. There is no obligation to purchase photos. Please arrive at least 20 minutes before your child's scheduled class time (if you are dressed and ready). Students will not have a regular class and rehearsals during this week. Please do not leave until the teacher dismisses you. All photo forms must be completed prior to pictures.
